Say: He is Allah the One and Only; Allah, the Eternal, Absolute; He begetteth not, nor is He begotten; And there is none like unto Him.

SURAH FALAQ, 3 times

Qul 'A`ūdhu Birabbi Al-Falaq. Min Sharri Mā Khalaq. Wa Min Sharri Ghāsiqin 'Idhā Waqab. Wa Min Sharri An-Naffāthāti Fī Al-`Uqad. Wa Min Sharri Ĥāsidin 'Idhā Ĥasad

Say: I seek refuge with the Lord of the Dawn, From the mischief of created things; From the mischief of Darkness as it overspreads; From the mischief of those who practice Secret Arts; And from the mischief of the envious one as he practices envy.

SURAH NAS, 3 times

Say: I seek refuge with the Lord and Cherisher of Mankind, The King (or Ruler) of Mankind. The Allah (or Judge) of Mankind. From the mischief of the Whisperer (of Evil), who withdraws (after his whisper) (The same) who whispers into the hearts of Mankind. Among Jinns and among Men.

VIRTUES:

Abdullah ibn Abbas (RA) narrates the Prophet said: The Surah: Al Zilzal is equal to half of the Qur'an, the Surah: Al Ikhlas is equal to one third of the Qur'an, and the Surah Al Kafiroon is equal to one fourth of the Qur'an. (Tirmidhi)

A'isha (RA) reported that whenever the Prophet * went to bed every night, he used to cup his hands together and blow over it after reciting Surat Al-Ikhlas, Surat Al-Falaq and Surat An-Nas, and then rub his hands over whatever parts of his body he was able to rub, starting with his head, face and front of his body. He used to do that three times. [Sahih al-Bukhari]

A'isha (RA) reported that whenever the Prophet # became sick, he would recite Mu'awwidhat (Surat Al-Falaq and Surat An-Nas) and then blow his breath over his body. When he became seriously ill, I used to recite (these two Surahs) and rub his hands over his body hoping for its blessings. [Sahih al-Bukhari]

VIRTUES:

Abu Ayub Al-Ansari (RA) narrates from the Prophet said: Whoever recites Ayat al Kursi, and the ayah (3:18), and ayah (3:26-27), Allah will forgive his sins, admit him into Paradise and take care of seventy (many) of his needs, the simplest being his forgiveness (Ruh al Ma'ani, with reference to Daylami)

Imam al Baghawi reports a hadith from the Prophet * in which he said: It is Allah's promise that anyone who recites, after every Salah, Surat al Fatihah, Ayat al Kursi, two verses of Allmran (3:18), and the aayahs (3:26-27), He will make his abode in Paradise, and have him place in the Sacred Enclosure, and bless him with His mercy seventy times every day, and fulfill seventy of his needs and protect him against every envier and enemy and make him prevail over them.

VIRTUES:

Al Bazzar, quoting his own chains of authority in his Musnad, report from Sayyidina Abu Hurairah (RA) that the Holy Prophet said: A person who has recited the Ayat al Kursi and the first three verses of Surah Mu'min, early during the day, he will, on that day, remain safe from everything bad and painful. It has also been reported by Tirmidhi. [Ibn Kathir/Ma'ariful Qur'an]

VIRTUES:

Amir ibn Qays (RA) said: Once I get to recite four verses of the Qur'an in the morning, I stop worrying about what happens in the morning and what would happen in the evening. They are as follows, and he recited the above verses. (Ruh al Ma'ani)

The Messenger believeth in what hath been revealed to him from his Lord, as do the men of faith. Each one (of them) believeth in Allah, His angels, His books, and His Messengers "We make no distinction (they say) between one and another of His Messengers." And they say: "We hear and we obey; (We seek) Thy forgiveness, Our Lord, and to Thee is the end of all journeys." On no soul doth Allah place a burden greater than it can bear. It gets every good that it earns and it suffers every ill that it earns. (Pray): "Our Lord! Condemn us not if we forget or fall into error; our Lord! Lay not on us a burden like that which Thou didst lay on those before us; Our Lord! Lay not on us a burden greater than we have strength to bear. Blot out our sins and grant us forgiveness. Have mercy on us. Thou art our Protector; help us against those who stand against faith." (2:285-286)

VIRTUES:

One who recites these two verses during the night, they will be sufficient from him (hadith)

Abdullah ibn Abbas (RA) narrates, the Prophet # said that Allah sent forth these verses out of the treasures of Paradise and the Rahman had already written them by His own hand two thousand years earlier than the creation of all things and beings. One who is able to recite them after the Salah of Isha, they will stand for tahajjud in his case.

Umar and Ali (RA) said that they thought that anybody who has any sense in him would never go to sleep without having recited these two verses.

VIRTUES:

Abu Darda' (RA) says: One who recites these verses three times, morning and evening, shall find that Allah Ta'ala makes things easy for him. (Qurtubi)

Mu'adh ibn Anas (RA) relates that this verse is the *dhikr* of Ibrahim (AS), which he used to recite in the morning and evening. (Ma'ariful Qur'an).

Abdullah ibn Abbas (RA) reports that the Messenger said that whosoever recites these verses in the morning and evening, all shortcomings in his acts during the day and night will be repaired. (Abu Dawood, Tabrani)

If he dies the same say, he will attain the status of a martyr. If a person recites the same words in the evening, he will attain the same status. [Tirmidhi, Mazhari]

And in another hadith a man came to the Prophet # and said: "What an affliction I received from a scorpion last night!" The Prophet # replied: "If you had said, when night fell, A'udhu bi kalimati-Llahit-tammati min sharri ma khalaq, it would not have harmed you."

Abu Hurairah (RA) reported the Prophet # said: He who recites in the morning and in the evening the statement: `Subhan-Allahi wa bihamdihi (Allah is free from imperfection and I begin with praising Him)' one hundred times, will not be surpassed on the Day of Resurrection by anyone with better deeds than one who utters the same words or utters more of these words. (Muslim)

Subhanallah wa bihamdihi 'adada khalqihi wa rida' nafsihi wa zinata 'arshihi wa midada kalimatihi

Allah is free from imperfection and I begin with His praise, as many times as the number of His creatures, in accordance with His Good Pleasure, equal to the weight of His Throne and equal to the ink that may be used in recording the words (for His Praise)

VIRTUES:

Juwairiyah (One of the wives of the Prophet *) reported that one day the Prophet *, left her apartment in the morning as she was busy observing her dawn prayer in her place of worship. He came back in the forenoon and she was still sitting there. The Prophet *, said to her, "You have been in the same place since I left you?" She said, "Yes." Thereupon the Prophet *, said, "I recited four words three times after I left you and if these were to be weighed against what you have recited since morning these would outweigh them, and these words are. (Recited the du'a) Reported by Muslim and Abu Daw'ud)

Radhitu billahi Rabba, Wa Bil Islami Deena, Wa bi Muhammadin (ﷺ) nabiyya(n) wa Rasula.

I've accepted Allah as my Lord, and Islam as my way of life, and Mohammad as a Prophet and Messenger.

VIRTUES:

Whosoever recites this, Paradise will become obligatory upon them.

Allahumma 'aafini fi badani, allahumma 'aafini fi sam'ee, allahumma 'aafini fi basari. Laa ilaaha illaa anta.

Oh Allah! Grant health to my body, to my hearing and to my sight. None has the right to be worshipped except You.

Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-hammi wal-Ḥuzni wal-'ajazi wal-kasli wal-bukhli wal-jubni wa dala'id-dayni wa ghalabatir-rijal.

VIRTUES:

It is established from the sunnah of the Messenger of Allah # that one should say, "Allahumma ajirni min an-nar," ('O Allah, save me from the Fire!') seven times after Maghrib and Fajr prayers. He told us (Allah bless him and give him peace) that saying it at Maghrib would grant one protection from the Fire if one died at night; and saying it at Fajr would grant one protection from the Fire if one died during the day. [Sunan Abi Dawud]

Ĥasbī Allāhu Lā 'llāha 'lllā Huwa `Alayhi Tawakkaltu Wa Huwa Rabbu Al-`Arshi Al-`Ažīmi

But if they turn away, Say: "Allah sufficeth me: There is not god but He: On Him is my trust - He the Lord of the Throne (of Glory) Supreme! (9:129)

VIRTUES:

Allah will grant whoever recites the last verse of Surah Tawbah 7 times in the morning and in the evening (time of Fajr and Asr), whatever he wants in the world or the next. (Abu Dawud)
